# Food Service Garment Design Guidelines

### No Buttons

- Closures should be snaps or secured hook & loop
- Why? All parts of the garment should be securely affixed so there is no chance that something could fall off and contaminate the food.

### No Pockets

- Why? Eliminates workers' ability to bring outside objects (phone, pen, etc.) that could contaminate the food, also provides a vessel for food to collect.
- Exception: Some facilities will accept pockets below the waist (ex. pant pockets) because they are made to fall below the level of where something could fall out and contaminate the food.

## No loose/hanging components

- No hook & loop tabs, drawstrings, etc.
- Why? Loose or hanging pieces in general can be a safety hazard in manufacturing. They also pose a possible point of contamination.
